



QIS Primary Learning Expectations 2020



Online learning expectations

All students will:

1. Ensure that they have an appropriate place to work and conduct live lessons. This place should be quiet, have good lighting and be comfortable.
2. Wear their QIS shirt and dress appropriately whilst participating in live lessons.
3. Ensure their camera is switched on whilst the register is checked at the start of the lesson. Keep their camera on as far as possible to ensure good behaviour and facilitate feedback.
4. Log in with school email.
5. Engage with the learning throughout the lesson.
6. Be expected to turn on microphones / camera (or comment in the chat) at any time if prompted by the teacher.

We would kindly ask that all parents support their children, and the school, with the above expectations.

Please note that lessons recordings are only accessible to the teacher, who will share these on Google Classroom with the relevant class only.

Your teacher will:

- Share the Google Meet link onto your Google classroom.
- Check attendance of all online lessons.
- Have their camera and microphone on.
- Provide work appropriate for online and in class learning.

ALL lessons learning expectations

All students will:

1. Observe appropriate health, safety and distancing rules.
2. Sanitise their hands before and after being in a classroom.
3. Remain in their seats throughout the lesson.
4. Use the appropriate materials assigned to them (stationary, exercise books etc.)
5. Send work to the teacher via Google classroom for feedback.
6. Take responsibility for their own behaviour and communication.
7. Behave in line with the QIS Primary Learner Profile stating the 3 R's: responsible, resilient and respectful.
8. Only engage in chat that is relevant to their learning.
9. Keep all their personal details confidential e.g. passwords, phone numbers, non-school email addresses, social media details.

Your teacher will:

- Remain at their desk, teach from there and not move away from their desk during lessons.
- Only feedback on work digitally or verbally.
- Provide learning that can be done face to face in the classroom as well as online.
